A group of mostly Stourbridge satin air trap glass, late 19th and early 20th century, including a rainbow example of ovoid shape, detailed 'PATENT', height 14cm, a bulbous yellow ground example with enamelled jewelled decoration of a bird on a blossoming branch, height 14cm, a green ground vase with vermicule type decoration, height 17.5cm, a similar pink example and a pair of blue ground vases (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1867. Visible surface scratches to inside rim and body of pink jug.

One pink bottle neck vase and one small blue vase have both been ground down in height.

Small chip to yellow glass feet on white/vari-coloured egg shaped vase.

Chip to one foot on one pink vase.

Minor age related wear.
