A Fabergé style gold, jade and rock crystal study of catkins, the gold textured stem with carved jade leaves, in a rock crystal vase, the stem terminal detailed '0750' and with indistinct maker's mark, total height 14.5cm. Note: the original Fabergé catkins study by Feodor Afanassiev is in the Royal Collection, having been acquired by Queen Alexandra in the early 1900s.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

2430. The gold stem and jade leaves appear to be in good order. Where the stem enters the rock crystal, there are some small chips around the opening. There are some very minor surface hairline scratches to the crystal and a tiny nick to the edge of the base. Otherwise in good condition.

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
