A mid-18th century silver étui of tapered oval form, each side decorated in relief with rococo scrolls framing fruit, the hinged lid revealing a fitted interior including scissors, rule, pocket knife, needle and tweezers, length 8.6cm. Note: a non-transferrable ivory exemption certificate has been granted for the sale of this item.

Condition Report

357. The case has a 2cm split to one side of the button. The hinge and catch are both a little loose but function as they should. The contents of the case appear to be period. The handles of the scissors are fairly bent out of shape. Solder repair marks just above the base. Dents to rear of case just above the hinge. General wear consistent with age and use.
