A Ridgway pale green ground Griffin and Cherub white sprigged jug and cover, circa 1815, with gilt rims, iron red pattern No. 3/102 to base, height 19.5cm, a similar jug, height 12cm, and a mixed group of sprigged feldspathic stonewares, mostly jugs, including some by Chetham & Woolley, with hunting scenes, classical panels and foliage (minor faults and restoration). Provenance: from the collection of the late Graham and Rhiannon Berridge.

Pale green ground jug and cover with some light brown staining and minor vertical haircrack by spout. White bodied jug with blue washed neck and spout has professional restoration to the spout.
