### Condition Report

303. The shoe has typical wear, with surface scratches, some dents and misshaping, particularly around the rim and lace holes. The silver is also a bit thin around rim and lace holes.

Marks are rubbed but still visible.

Oak base is intact. Interior has been partly filled.
