A Chinese pale celadon jade jar and cover, 20th century, the domed cover carved in low relief with a dragon emerging through vapours rising to a head finial, the squat circular body decorated with lotus and scrolling tendrils, flanked by a pair of carved and pierced archaic mask and loose ring handles, raised on three elephant mask feet, height 14.8cm, width across handles 18.2cm, with hardwood stand.

Condition Report

1084. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Some minor nicks/scuffs to highpoints. Quite obvious from the images, there is an inclusion to the centre of the cover which encircles the dragon head finial and a hairline inclusion to one side which runs across the rim and body either side of the handle.
