A Sino-Tibetan brown patinated and gilt bronze figure of Buddha, Qing dynasty, possibly 17th/18th century, modelled wearing a long gilt robe, his right hand raised in abhaya mudra, unusually seated on a breakfront throne with engraved foliate borders, height 14.5cm.

## Condition Report

1004. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical surface scratches and wear to highpoints, particularly to gilt on knee area. The two loop fittings to the back of the throne would suggest that the figure may have originally been fitted with a mandala or similar.
