A pair of Japanese Kutani porcelain koros and covers, Meiji period, each globular body painted with a landscape, on tripod feet, height 18cm (one cracked, the other with minor faults), together with a Japanese Imari vase and domed cover, Meiji period, height 29.8cm (chipped rim), a blue and white inkwell, and a blue and white vase.

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1034. Koro 1 - finial has been broken off and re-glued, 3cm hairline to rim of cover, diagonal crack across the body. Enamels in generally good condition with typical minor surface scratches and wear.

Koro 2 - finial has been broken off and re-glued in place with a pin, finial also chipped to tail and foot, cover is chipped and has two faint hairlines, body in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs.

Typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels.

Imari jar - large chip to rim, otherwise ok and cover in sound condition. Both pieces with typical surface wear.

Blue and white vase - good condition.

Blue and white inkwell - broken and repaired corner, and lacking cover.
