A Chinese famille rose armorial export porcelain meat dish, Qianlong period, painted and gilt with a central figural scene above a coat of arms and below a crest, flanked by grisaille landscape vignettes, length 37cm (repaired). Provenance: from the private collection of David Armitage, former conservator to the Department of Eastern Art at the Ashmolean Museum, Oxford, between 1970 and 1999.

Condition Report

1204. One side of the dish has been broken off in two pieces and re-glued. Small filled repair to rim at source of crack. Typical surface scratches and wear to gilt, enamels and glaze.
