A Japanese Arita blue and white tokkuri (sake flask), Edo period, of slightly tapered square form, the shoulder and four sides painted with trailing vines, beneath a short flared neck, height 23.6cm.

Condition Report

1208. Good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches to glaze. Minor glaze blemishes/pitting. Small firing crack running horizontally just above the base (6.5cm long). there is then a small hairline rinning off the end of the firing crack diagonally across the corner of the base.
