A Chinese crackle glazed vase, late Qing dynasty, the ogee baluster body decorated in relief with iron oxide washed dragon, flaming pearl and tiger, the mustard glazed flared neck with iron oxide keyfret rim above moulded mask and ring handles, on a pale blue glazed flared foot, incised pseudo seal mark to base, height 50.2cm.
