### LOT 3045

An early 19th century sea service pattern percussion pistol, barrel length 15.5cm, the lock marked 'Tower', with swing-over ramrod, full-stocked with brass furniture (lacking hammer), together with a George III period flintlock pistol, barrel length 22cm, with ornate cast brass furniture.

### Condition Report

3045. Overall both guns need extensive repair work.

Sea Service pattern pistol - lost hammer, belt slide broken, pin holes to wooden frame below barrel. Some spring present with trigger, but mechanism needs attention. Generally an honest looking gun needing work.

George III period pistol - trigger action sloppy but does work. Overall steel work is pitted and in places heavily cleaned back. Some shrinkage on wood around bras and steel work. Loss to metalwork around trigger plate. Some delamination around barrel tip. Split to wooden grip and split to wooden stock below barrel. Overall honest but quite extensive work needed.
