A gold, silver set and diamond oval cluster ring, claw set with the closed back principal oval cut diamond within a surround of eight cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 3.1g, ring size approx Q.

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

All diamonds present.

There is likely a foil backing to the diamonds. The central diamond without magnification looks to have a dirty/speckled brown appearance. When using a 10x loupe, this coloration is actually beneath the stone and is likely the degrading of the foil backing. The interior of the central diamond looks to be fairly clear of inclusions but it is difficult to tell due to the discoloration. The stone does have a couple of chips to the top outer edge/girdle, one of which runs underneath the stone.

The claws look to be in generally good condition, one or two beginning to show slight signs of wear, but all stones are currently secure.

Some slight wear to the shank.
