A platinum, emerald and diamond ring, 1920s, claw set with the cut cornered rectangular step cut emerald between baguette cut diamond stepped shoulders, detailed 'Pt', weight 2.8g, emerald weight approx 1.20ct, ring size approx N, with a later Garrard & Co Ltd case.

Estimate: £2,000 - £2,500

Condition Report

The emerald has a few nibble to the girdle and table facet edge. It has a couple of surface reaching inclusions, one on the edge of the table.

Fairly good clarity to the emerald, with a cluster of inclusions on one side. Claws securing emerald are in good condition.

Diamonds are secure in their setting. Diamond grading estimations - colour H/I, clarity VS.

Slightest of wear to the sides of the mount, with typical light surface scratching and rubbing to the shank/setting.

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
