An 18ct gold and diamond ring, designed as two entwined snakes, each snake's head mounted with a cushion cut diamond, London 1916, weight 6.1g, ring size approx W.

Estimate: £300 - £400

Condition Report

One diamond has a chip to one side of the table facet edge, plus another chip to the girdle.
No obvious evidence of resizing to the shank. Hallmark is fairly clear and readable.
Some typical scratching/rubbing to the shank overall, slight thinning.
The piece is a little dirty as present and will benefit from a clean.

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
