## LOT 800

A Victorian gold, banded agate and diamond oval hinged bangle, 1860s, each terminal mounted with a spherical banded agate and three tapering rows of rose cut diamonds, registration mark, total weight 52g, inside width 5cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

## Condition Report

The piece is generally in good condition for its age.

One of the banded agates has a surface crack to the underside, which is not detrimental. Otherwise the agates have some typical light scratching noticeable under a 10x loupe.

One diamond is lacking.

There is some evidence of testing the piece for gold in the past, i.e. a few deliberate deeper scratches on one small area on one side, plus some other scratching between one of the hinges.

Some typical light scratching/wear overall.

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
