A 9ct gold ring, claw set with a circular cut amethyst, London 1963, fitted with a sizing band, weight 4g, ring size approx J1/2, and a gold, gilt metal and amethyst single stone ring, detailed '9ct', weight 2.4g, ring size approx O1/2.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

9ct gold and amethyst ring - a couple of scratches to the table facet of the amethyst. Claws in good condition, typical light scratching to the shank/setting.

Gold, gilt metal, amethyst ring - the ring is quite crudely constructed, the head of the ring is earlier (possibly Victorian) than the shank. There is evidence below the shoulders where the shank has been joined. The head of the ring is likely a gilt metal, some evidence of it wearing down to a base metal on one shoulder. Some general denting, scratching to the setting, rubbing/loss of definition to the decoration. The amethyst within its collet setting is not rigidly fixed in place, it moves within the head of the ring.
