Attributed to Thomas Rowlandson - Gaming at Brook's Club, 19th century watercolour, 14cm x 21cm, within an ebonized and gilt frame.

Note: this work sits comfortably amongst a group of Rowlandson's drawings that share the same fundamental composition with minor differences to figure groupings and objects - see 'Gaming at Brook's Cub' (London Museum collection); 'Rooks Waiting for Pigeons' Bonhams 15th April 2021, lot no. 245; 'British Club Scene' (Brown University collection).

65. Faded with associated muting of colours. Overall light browning and age toning. Browning slightly heavier around the edge of the mount. One small spot of foxing above the table on the left. Mount is not archival and has some detritus trapped on it. Frame has minor chips and scuffs.
