A late 19th century French silvered and brown patinated bronze mantel clock in the form of a knight's helmet with dragon finial, the eight day movement striking on a gong, the circular dial with inset enamel hour plaques with blue Roman numerals, the case cast with foliate scrolls, strapwork and studded bands, on a tasselled cushion and scroll base, height 37.8cm (lacking pendulum).

Estimate: £200 - £400

Condition Report

1230. Both hands are present but the minute hand is broken and detached.

The clock case has wear to the patina all over, but no significant damage or repairs. Both hinged doors are good with glass to front in good order.

Both trains of movement wind smoothly, but no pendulum so unable to say it is running.

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
