### LOT 1217

A late 19th century French brass four glass mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the backplate stamped with Japy Frères maker's mark, with mercury compensated pendulum, the white enamelled circular dial with black Roman hour numerals, the case with engraved decoration and bevelled glass panels, on bracket feet, height 26cm, with winding key.

Estimate: £150 - £250

### Condition Report

1217. The clock is in generally good order. The case is a little dusty and dirty so would benefit from a clean, however engraving is still nice and crisp and all glass panels appear to be in good order.

Typical light surface scratches and wear. Both doors open and close tightly.

Dial has a chip at 6 o'clock.

Movement winds and starts to run, with striking mechanism also working as it should, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch, and it would probably benefit from a clean/service.

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
