A late 19th Century French Siena marble cased mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the enamelled chapter ring with black Roman hour numerals, the case with arched surmount, on a stepped base and brass bracket feet, height 30cm, with pendulum and winding key.

Condition Report

1232. The clock is in generally good condition.

The case is clean with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear and some very minor nicks to edges.

Dial is good and clean.

Both hinges to doors are good, glass to front door in good order and closes tightly.

Both trains of movement wind smoothly, strike mechanism working as it should, and currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
