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A George III mahogany longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 12-inch brass breakarch dial with subsidiary silvered date dial and rolling moon to arch, above a silvered chapter ring, inscribed 'John Sudaway London', framing a matt centre with silvered subsidiary seconds and date aperture, all cornered with cast and pierced gilt spandrels, the hood with moulded arch pediment and brass finials above a glazed door, flanked by brass stop fluted columns, the trunk with arched door above a plain base and plinth, height 223cm, with pendulum and pair of brass cased weights.

Condition Report

1261. Generally good condition, would certainly benefit from a clean.

The case is in generally good order with typical splits to arch of hood, case sides and mouldings. Some alterations/replacements to hinges and locks. Plinth looks like a later addition.

Dial is generally good with typical light wear.

Movement is a bit dusty and dirty, would suggest a clean/overhaul would return it to working order. Clock winds smoothly and runs, strike mechanism also in working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
