An early Victorian mahogany drop dial wall timepiece with eight day single fusee movement, the 12-inch painted dial with black Roman hour numerals within a moulded circular surround, the bowed apron with brass inlay and glazed lenticle, flanked by a pair of carved fan mouldings, height 52cm, with pendulum and winding key.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1238. Generally fairly good condition with typical wear but no significant damage. Typical wear and re-touching to painted dial. Original putty holding glass in to bezel replaced with a sealant, but all secure and not visible until the door is opened.

Movement winds smoothly and runs, but only for 4-5 minutes before stopping. Would suggest a clean/overhaul would return it to full working order.
