A late 19th century leather mounted brass single-draw telescope, detailed 'Dollond London Day or Night', unextended length 49.8cm, together with a 19th century mahogany and brass telescope by Dollond of London, the 109cm body tube on a folding brass tripod stand, total length 136.5cm (split to mahogany tube).

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1291. Dollond brass and leather telescope - generally good condition. Typical surface scratches and wear. Some minor dents to brass tube. Leather mount with typical scuffs and wear, and slightly loose on the barrel. Brass ends slightly loose with one securing screw missing underneath the sliding shade. A little hazy/dusty when looking through, but glass appears to be ok.

Tripod stand telescope - couple of splits to mahogany tube, typical surface scratches and wear to brass and wood. Some small dents to brass tube, eyepiece with small section split out around the thread area. Brass end with some dents. Tripod with typical wear, but otherwise good. No view through the telescope.
