An early 20th century French lacquered brass cased carriage clock with eight day movement striking and repeating on a gong, the backplate stamped with 'G.B&E' maker's mark and numbered '31121', the cream dial with black Roman hour numerals, the case with bevelled glass panels, fluted corner columns and foliate scroll handle, on corner mounts and scroll feet, height 19.7cm.

Condition Report

1201. The clock is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs.

Case a little dusty with typical light surface scratches and wear. All glass panels in good order and good clean dial.

Movement winds smoothly, adjusts smoothly and striking mechanism working with gong strike on hours and half hours, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
