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An early Victorian mahogany longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 12-inch painted breakarch dial with landscape scene to arch, subsidiary seconds and date aperture and inscribed 'S. Granville Devonport', the arched hood with turned finials, glazed door and columns, the arched trunk door flanked by a pair of reeded cut corner columns, on a plain base and bracket feet, height 219cm, with pendulum and two weights. Note: Samuel Granville is a recorded Devon clockmaker working at Fore Street, Devonport, Plymouth.

Condition Report

1274. The clock is in fairly good condition.

The case with no significant damage but typical splits to hood and chips/loss to veneers in places. Nice figuring to mahogany.

Dial has some craquelure, as well as being a bit dirty and worn.

Movement winds but does not currently run. A service/overhaul would likely return it to working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Later replacement weights.

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
