2659. Case exterior and interior both quite scuffed and marked. Tune sheet browned and torn around edges. Nine tips are missing off the comb. Seems to have a slight knocking at times when playing, but does seem to be working and playing all the airs, although we would suggest mechanism will need an overhaul and we do not guarantee the working order or reliability of any purchased item.
