An Edwardian Arts and Crafts oak framed hall settle, designed by G.M. Ellwood, the shaped top rail above vertical slats, finely inlaid in various woods with flowers and leaves, the base fitted with two drawers, height 101cm, width 178cm, depth 61cm. Note: for a very similar example see Christie's, 21st September 2010, Lot 265.

Condition Report

2301. Overall in good condition. No obvious damage or repair, just general wear consistent with age and use. Lacking one handle on one drawer and one button on the seat upholstery. Seat cushion is filled with horse hair and is a little flat but still functions well. The bases of each foot have a felt pad which is covering a hole for a castor.
