LOT 575

An 18ct gold and diamond ring, designed as a coiled snake, the head mounted with a row of five graduated cushion cut diamonds, London 1915, weight 9.6g, ring size approx R.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

Typical surface scratching, a few deeper scratches in places. Some overall slight wear.
Loss of definition to the eyes of the snake, one is completely absent, the other is rubbed.
Largest diamond has a surface reaching inclusion/cavity to one side of the table. The second largest diamond has a large significant section lacking. The second smallest diamond has a cleavage chip to one side of the table.
Total diamond weight, very approximately 0.15-0.20ct.

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
