A platinum and diamond ring, claw set with the principal circular cut diamond between diamond set three stone shoulders, weight 3.4g, principal diamond weight approx 2.65ct, ring size approx N1/2.

Estimate: £4,000 - £6,000

Condition Report

Estimation of diamond grading (for guidance only and limited by the setting): Principal stone - colour: I/J, clarity: SI2. Faint florescence.

The centre stone has an eye visible inclusion running between two claws onto the edge of the table facet.

The principal stone is a more modern cut of stone, with a large table facet, a fairly shallow crown, with no culet.

One side stone is chipped, one side diamond on the other side has a surface reaching inclusion.

Claws have been re-tipped in the past. Typical light scratching to the shank/setting overall.
