An Edwardian 18ct gold and diamond five stone ring, mounted with a row of graduated cushion cut diamonds, London 1907, weight 2.7g, ring size approx J1/2.

Estimate: £250 - £300

Condition Report

The central diamond has a significant surface reaching fracture running across the stone through the table. All the diamonds have some minor abrasion to the table facet edges, likely from being stored with other diamonds.

Estimation of diamond gradings (for guidance only and limited by the setting): all stones other than the central stone average clarity SI1, colour overall - H/I. Total diamond weight approx 0.50ct.

A few of the claws have been re-tipped in the past, one or two others are showing signs of wear.

Some noticeable wear to the sides of the mount where the ring has been worn against other rings.

Typical slight scratching to the shank/setting overall.

Resized in the past.

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
