### LOT 1506

A Doulton Lambeth stoneware bowl by George Tinworth and Louisa E. Edwards, dated 1882, of shallow circular form, decorated with blue glazed foliate scrolls alternating with similar green glazed scroll panels, raised on paw feet, impressed and incised marks to base, diameter 25.5cm (faults and restoration), together with a small Doulton Lambeth jug, height 10cm, and a Worcester blue floral printed double-spouted teapot and cover.

### Condition Report

PLEASE NOTE THIS IS A PARTIAL CONDITION REPORT ONLY DETAILING THE DOULTON BOWL

Doulton bowl - 2 narrow restored rim chips to rim each approx 3cm long which are noticeable due to the poor colour matching. The bowl interior is heavily scratched with a manufacturing glaze blemish. There is a long fine haircrack running along the length of the bowls diameter visible only to the underside, it encroaches into the decorative side of the bowl and disappears amidst the decoration.
