A Wedgwood Fairyland lustre Melba centre bowl, designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones, decorated to the interior with the Jumping Faun pattern, the Garden of Paradise pattern to the exterior, gilt printed Portland Vase mark to base and indistinct pattern number reference, height 14.5cm. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

The bowl 'rings' true - there are no cracks, chips or restoration.

The gilding and exterior decoration is in generally good order with only minor typical wear primarily nearer the rim.

The interior of the bowl has a greater degree of wear to the gilding, noticeably to the centre base which is almost completely rubbed of gilding. The degree of wear lessens the further up the bowl interior you go, with the upper half displaying hardly any wear or rubbing.

The darker enamel colours are a little run, particularly to the interior.

There are typical overall light surface scratches to the glaze commensurate with age and use.
