A pair of Sèvres style ormolu mounted green ground porcelain ewers, 19th century, each painted with a floral arrangement within gilt foliate scroll framing, the mounts cast with scrolling foliage and a mask beneath each spout, the high scroll handles above amorini, raised on spiral stems and foliate feet, blue painted pseudo Minton marks to bases, height 16.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

One of the ewers has lost its screw fitting which holds on the green glazed foot and ormolu base to the metal stem.

Otherwise both the ewers are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

The gilding is typically a little rubbed and there are some light typical surface scratches with some minor firing blemishes.
