A pair of Helena Wolfsohn Dresden porcelain perfume flasks with metal stoppers, late 19th century, of flattened pear shape, painted in Meissen style with figural harbourside scenes between gilt enriched fluted moulding, underglaze blue crowned 'D' mark to bases, height 11.5cm.

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### Condition Report

One has a number of small nicks to the outer edge of the foot.

Both have light surface scratches to the painting.

The stoppers are different but of a similar ilk.

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
