LOT 1859

An opaque white and cobalt blue flashed and cut clear glass scent bottle and stopper, Bohemian, late 19th/early 20th century, of hexagonal baluster shape gilt with foliate scrollwork above stylized leaf cut panels, the collared neck beneath a pointed stopper, height 14cm, together with a small group of Continental glassware, including a ruby goblet, engraved with a huntsman and dogs flanked by gilt fruiting vines and enamelled flowers, height 13.5cm, a spa beaker and a pair of opaline vases, height 11cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

White and blue scent - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration - some very minor rubbing to the gilding.

Huntsman ruby goblet - filled chip to one section of foot, gilding rubbed.

Spa beaker - small chips/nicks to foot, light surface wear.

Pair opaline vases - chip to outer rim edge of one, both with rubbed/worn enamels and gilding.

Ruby vase with foliate scrollwork - bolted repair to stem, gilt rim rubbed.

Pink vase with parrots - chip to outer rim edge, gilding rubbed.

Blue vase - in good condition.
