### LOT 1509

A Swanea porcelain London shape trio, circa 1820, pattern No. 219, painted in gilt enriched Imari colours with a bird perched on rockwork amidst flowers and foliage, within an iron red and gilt decorated floral ground reserved with oval floral panels, unmarked, diameter of saucer 14.7cm, together with a similar small plate, diameter 17.8cm, and a London decorated Swanea porcelain saucer in the style of Sims, unmarked, diameter 15cm.

Estimate: £150 - £250

### Condition Report

Coffee cup - doesn't 'ring' as there is a fine vertical hairline running alongside the handle, very light and minor wear to gilding.

Teacup - doesn't 'ring' as there is a vertical haircrack running down the body of the cup which has a tiny slither chip at its start on the rim. There is a firing crack to the handle.

Saucer - tiny manufacturers indent blemish to rim edge, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Very light wear to gilding.

Plate - gilt rim edge and cavetto rubbed, otherwise in good condition overall.

Other saucer - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, very light wear and surface scratches.
