A garniture of five Moser amber tinted crackle glass vases, 1900-25, each enamelled with aquatic weed, three additionally with fish, unmarked, height of tallest 11.5cm (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Widest bulbous shaped vase - large branched crack to body disguised by the 'ice' detail.

Pair of ovoid shape - one has some wear to the enamels but is otherwise ok, the other has a small chip to the outer top rim edge and a glued repair and associated chip to the foot.

Pair of dimpled square shape - one has a large chip and a small nick to the foot, the other has a chipped neck rim.
