A large mixed group of cabinet cups and saucers, including a fluted Caughley teabowl and saucer, gilt with foliate swags beneath a gilt overlaid cobalt blue rim, underglaze blue mark to bases, a Hilditch cup and saucer with pink lustre line and foliate decoration, a Royal Crown Derby Japan pattern teacup and saucer, a Bodley trembleuse cup and saucer, a Barr Worcester teacup and saucer with black painted floral decoration, Mintons, Pratt, George Jones and Ridgway (minor faults).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

Fundamentally each item in the lot is in good condition overall and 'rings' well when tapped. There is typical minimal wear/surface scratches to varying degrees, but nothing untoward or terrible and only commensurate with age and use.

The following are more significant issues:

Coffee cup and saucer decorated with flowers on a gilt band, pattern number 3038 - the cup is heavily crazed and stained.

George Jones gilt overlaid cobalt blue ground saucer - cracked.

Pratt pottery black ground can and saucer - doesn't 'ring' as pottery, heavily crazed.

Slop bowl - cracked.

Pink rose and gilt decorated trio. pattern number 2907 - teacup doesn't 'ring' as heavily crazed.

Pink lustre line decorated teacup and saucer, pattern number 1056 - saucer cracked and chipped, cup heavily crazed so doesn't 'ring'.

Mintons pink rose garland trio - plate crazed so doesn't 'ring'.

Scattered stylized flowers teacup and saucer - teacup cracked.

Coalport scattered blue flowers cup and saucer - saucer heavily crazed and stained so doesn't 'ring'.

Floral pink lustre teacup and saucer - both pieces crazed so don't 'ring'.

Dragonfly cup and saucer - marked 'Brownfield', the cup has a small vertical haircrack.
