A Royal Worcester Lady Evelyn pattern part service, comprising six cups and saucers, six tea plates, jug, sugar bowl and cake plate (one cup handle repaired), a Limoges part dessert service, decorated with gilt enriched cornflowers, and a small group of other ceramics, including a pair of Limoges coffee cans and saucers, painted by Marcadet, signed, for Mappin & Webb, and four Brown-Westhead Moore & Co floral painted plates (some faults and repairs).

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

Lady Evelyn :

One teacup with visibly repaired handle.

Some crazing to jug.

Plates are overall a little scratched but just through normal use.

Remaining items in good condition overall.

Four Brown-Westhead Moore & Co plates - one has a glued and chipped repair to the rim.

Paragon floral plate - in good condition.

Limoges dessert service - oval shaped dish visibly and poorly restored, two trefoil shaped dishes ok, plates ok.

6 blue rimmed floral printed tea plates - ok.

Pair Mappin & Webb cans and saucers - ok.

Pair Copeland Spode blue printed cans and saucers - don't 'ring' well but generally ok.

Dresden Flowers black printed cup and saucer - saucer cracked.

Turquoise rimmed floral painted cup and saucer - misfiring to turquoise and some flaking.

Remaining items in lot in good condition.
