An Art Deco Carter, Stabler Adams Ltd Poole Pottery vase, circa 1930, painted by Winifred Collett in pattern GJ, height 14cm, together with a mixed group of other Art Deco and mid-20th century ceramics, including a Shorter and Son fish service, other Poole, a Branksome coffee set, three Susie Cooper teapots and a Royal Doulton cream glazed vase, height 22cm (minor faults).

Condition Report

Susie Cooper green teapot - some crazing to cover, light scratching to teapot spout.

Susie Cooper blue teapot, jug and sugar bowl - heavily stained and crazed.

Poole vase - crazed with some staining to interior.

Shorter fish set - crazed, one plate with minor chip to underside rim edge, otherwise ok.

Grafton Lilleshall cup and saucer - cup crazed.

Burleigh and Empire cup and saucer - both crazed.

Branksome coffee pot - small chip to upper rim edge, 2 Branksome coffee cups cracked.

Poole magnolia melon shaped dish - crazed with small haircrack.

Crown Ducal jug - crack to upper handle terminal.

Spode Velamour vase - starcrack to base, stained interior.

Otherwise all items in the lot in good condition overall.
