A Bristol porcelain coffee cup, circa 1780, the baluster body with scroll handle capped with relief moulded harebells, enamelled with scattered pink rosebuds between laurel and gilt banding, blue painted 'X' and 'S' to base, height 7cm, together with another Bristol cup, painted with floral swags, a Chelsea Derby cup with foliate garlands, gilt painted mark to base, a Keeling fluted teabowl and a Pinxton saucer, diameter 14.5cm (minor faults). Provenance: the saucer previously part of the Godden Reference Collection.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Bristol cup with rosebuds - minuscule nick to gilt top rim edge, some very minor wear/rubbing to gilding overall, manufacturers firing crack to handle.

Bristol cup with swags - 2 small firing cracks to handle, gilt rim in particular rubbed, otherwise ok.

Chelsea Derby cup - small chip to inner rim edge by handle, some rubbing to gilt rim.

Keeling teabowl - 3 tiny nicks to top rim edge.

Saucer - small chip and associated very short haircrack to rim, heavily scratched surface.
