LOT 1923

A pair of craquelure ice glass comports with entwined green snake decoration to the stems, probably French, circa 1850, height 22.5cm, a similar smaller pair, entwined with red snakes, height 18.5cm, and a small group of similar glassware with snake detail, including two goblets (minor faults and repairs). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Larger pair of comports entwined with green snakes - in good condition overall, no damage or repairs, gilt detail to snakes worn.

Pair of comports entwined with red snakes - one with minute nick to upper rim edge, more easily felt than seen, significant areas of gilding loss to rim of this comport, otherwise both in good condition.

Vase entwined with red snake - gilding loss otherwise ok.

Two goblets - example with red snake with glued break to top of stem.

Blue snake handled jug - crack to body of snake at lower terminal adhesion.

Two jars and covers with green snakes - one with heavily rubbed gilding.

Two jars and covers with red snakes - one with rubbing to gilding.

Otherwise items in the lot in good condition.
