A mixed group of English pottery and porcelain printed wares, 19th century and later, including a Miles Mason blue chinoiserie teacup and saucer, two teacups and saucers and two saucer dishes by New Hall in the Broseley pattern, a Rogers Zebra pattern soup plate, diameter 24cm, two English Scenery soup plates and a puce printed New Hall jug (minor faults).

Estimate: £60 - £80

Condition Report

Zebra plate - minute nick to rim at 10 o'clock, surface heavily scratched.

Puce jug - chip to foot, bruised starcrack to interior side edge.

Booths plate - minor hairline to rim.

Cauldon two handle oval dish - chip to underside edge of one handle.

3 Willow pattern tea plates - 2 crazed and stained.

Chinoiserie overpainted blue printed saucer - crazed with chip to footrim.

Diminutive red printed Chinoiserie saucer - crazed .

Doulton Peace and Victory mug - starcrack to base.

Davenport gilt edged plate - crazed but ok.

Davenport gilt edged saucer - crazed but ok.

Sandbach gilt edge ogee shaped cup - crazed but ok.

Small teapot - crazed, chipping to tip of spout, cover crazed with light staining to edge of cover and flange where cover sits.

Remaining items in lot are in good condition overall with no damage or repair, the gilding displays typical wear.
