A Moser Neodymium Dichroic bowl, Alexandrit or Alexandrite glass, probably designed by Heinrich Hussmann, circa 1925-30, of circular shape with slice cut facets, acid etched 'Moser' mark to base, diameter 14.3cm, together with another Moser bowl of triangular shape, post-war, and a large Dichroic vase, probably Moser, height 23cm.
