A Minton majolica jardinière, dated 1864, the cobalt blue glazed body of inverted baluster form, applied with six vertical straps, each with a lion mask and ring handle above a paw foot, pink glazed interior, painted and impressed marks to base with shape No. 1023, height 36cm (restored).

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

Overall the damage and repairs are minimal.

Two feet have been professionally restored.

Two of the rings held in the lion's mouths have been restored - one above one of the restored feet.

Approx 10cm long vertical haircrack to rim emanating from a firing crack, and another fainter similar firing crack.

A couple of minor nicks to the relief strapwork, nothing untoward.

A few typical manufacturers firing cracks amidst the moulding.
