An early 19th century provincial oak longcase clock with thirty-hour movement striking on a bell, the painted dial inscribed 'Lewitt Leicester', the case with overall mahogany crossbanding, height 213cm, width 50cm, with pendulum and weight (alterations).

### Condition Report

2002. Please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Movement looks relatively clean, it has been altered from an 8 day movement at some stage and has two filled-on holes on the dial. The clock will certainly need some level of work, and at least a set-up once in place. The case has a repair to the right side swan neck, a split to the right side of the case and some gapping to the timbers on the front panel of the base.
