A pair of Charles Horner silver and enamelled cufflinks, the circular fronts with pale blue and white enamelled decoration, Chester 1913, weight 5.4g, diameter of each front 1.5cm, with a later case, and a gold, silver set and cultured pearl stickpin, detailed '9ct', weight 1.3g.

Condition Report

Cufflinks - very minor nicks to the central white enamel, otherwise enamel is in generally good condition. Hallmarks are fairly clear, slight rubbing to 'CH' maker's mark and to 'Silver' marks on the backs. Overall tarnishing to the silver.

Stickpin - some tarnishing to the setting of the cultured pearl, otherwise in generally good condition.

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
