A gold, ruby and diamond ring, claw set with the oval cut ruby between two principal cushion cut diamonds, otherwise set with six small diamonds at intervals, the mount with scroll pierced sides, detailed '18ct', weight 4.3g, ruby weight approx 1.10-1.20ct, total diamond weight approx 0.80-0.90ct, ring size approx M, with a case.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

Ruby approx. 6.9mm x 6.25mm x 3.3mm Fairly scratched table and abraded facet edges. Minimal sign of inclusions within the stone, though the setting and condition of table restrict the view.

The ruby has not been tested by a gem lab. We therefore cannot be certain the stone has not been treated to enhance colour/clarity.

The ruby has a chip to the girdle.

Some slight wear to the claws

Typical scratching to the shank/setting.

The ring could possibly date from the late 19th/early 20th century.

Principal diamonds - estimations of grading (limited by setting and for guidance only):

1st side diamond - I1 clarity

2nd side diamond - SI clarity

Colour overall approx. I/J

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
