### LOT 656

A 9ct gold oval hinged bangle on a snap clasp, Birmingham 1910, weight 4.8g, inside width 5.6cm, a 9ct gold mounted bloodstone and agate rotating fob, Birmingham 1893, a 9ct gold and green stained agate pendant fob, London 1963, total weight 10.6g, and a gilt metal ropetwist link long guard chain.

Estimate: £120 - £160

### Condition Report

Bangle - slight split and denting to the aperture of the clasp. The clasp does not easily fasten into place. Generally a few dents here and there to the sides.

Rotating fob - couple of chips to the bloodstone, a few nibbles to the edges of the agate, both with some light scratching. Some wear to the suspension loops, and the pins attached to the fob are quite loose.

Fob - some wear/rubbing to the design, the green stained agate has minimal wear.

Gilt long chain - some slight wear to the gilding in places, with some areas of discoloration. Some splitting to links, one area in particular has lost a few links, with only one link holding the chain together.
